Day 1 : Chiang Mai > Mae Hiab > Doi Suthep Foothill > Baan Hong > Doi Inthanon

06:30 Birding guide pick you up at hotel

Incase of pick you up at the Airport, Please let me know your number flight, guide will waiting for you at arrival hall with sightboard

Half day birding around CNX, Then transfer 20 min. to **Mae Hiab Agricultural University**, where inside is mostly an open farmlands, star birds for here such as Wire-tailed Swallow, Red Avadavat, Rufous-winged Buzzard, Red-billed Blue Magpie, Green Bee-eater, Lianated, Copper-smith Barbet, Olive-backed Sunbird, Pied Buschat and more.

Then **Foothill Doi Suthep bird hide** : Green Peafowl, White-crested Laughingthrush, Asian Barred Owlet(roosting), Brown Boobook(roosting), Red Junglefowl, White-rumped Shama, Black-crested Bulbul, Red-billed Blue Magpie and more.

Then to **Bann Hong Wildlife Resv.** (40 mins) to look for Green Peafowl (for here is easy to take photo) Then drive 1 hour to Doi Inthanon

Meal : None

Stay : Touch Star Resort (click)

Day 2 : Doi Inthanon National Park

After breakfast at the hotel, drive 10 min. to see **Blossom-headed Parakeet** in dry forest, the place near by resort. Then drive to **Doi Inthanon**, we will stop on the way at foothill where the main habitat is dry dipterocarp forest, key birds is Collared Falconet(uncommon), White-rumped Falconet(rare), Black-headed Woodpecker.

Next stop **Wachirathar Waterfall** the highlights is White-capped Redstart, Blue Whistling Thrush, Plumbeous Redstart, Slaty-backed Forktail.

We will spend two full day birding inside Doi Inthanon National Park, We will searching the highlight spots which including

1) The Second Check Point (Km.38); species that can be found in this zone such as Mountain Tailorbird, Rufous-bellied and Small Niltavas, White-gorgeted Flycatcher, White-browed Scimitar-Babbler, Yellow-cheeked Tit, Grey-cheeked Fulvetta, Dark-backed, Rufous-backed and Long-tailed Sibias, Asian Emerald Cuckoo, Chestnut-tailed Minla, Grey-headed Canary Flycatcher, White-browed Piculet, White-throated Fantail, Silver-eared Mesia, Spectacled Barwing, Hume's Treecreeper, Grey-chinned, Long-tailed, Short-billed and Scarlet Minivets, Flavescent, Mountain and White-headed Bulbuls.

2.) The highest summit (and also the highest peak of Thailand) at 2,685 meters above sea level. The summit of the park has a very unique ecosystem with *Rhododendron spp.* covered all over the top and there is the country only peat swamp right on the summit. This special habitat holds a number of unique species that are almost impossible to find elsewhere in Thailand and we will make a special effort to explore this area for those great birds such as Green-tailed Sunbird (UNCOMMON), Mrs Gould's Sunbird, Grey Bushchat, Ashy-throated Warbler(LOCALLY ENDEMIC), Chestnut-tailed Minla, Blue-winged Minla, White-throated and Yellow-bellied Fantails, Rufous-winged Fulvetta, Grey-bellied Tesia, Dark-backed Sibia, Snowy-browed Flycatcher, Red-flanked Bluetail, White-browed and Lesser Shortwings, Pygmy Wren Babbler, Davison's Leaf Warbler, Rufous-throated Partridge, Chestnut-crowned Laughingthrush, Dark-sided Thrush, Eurasian Woodcock and a lot more good species.

3.) General area ; The park's mid-elevation birds that can be seen here such as Collared Falconet, Great Barbet, Orange-bellied Leafbird, Great Tit, Hill Prinia, White-headed Bulbul, Grey Treepie, Chestnut-bellied, Chestnut-vented and Velvet-fronted Nuthatches, Black-throated Parrotbill, White-tailed Robin, Scaly Thrush, Chestnut-flanked White-eye, etc.

4.) Waterfalls ; there are few waterfalls inside the park, where we stand a good chance to see White-capped Water Redstart, Slaty-backed and White-crowned Forktail, and other more stream preferring species.

5.) Huay Sai Luang Waterfall ; Orange-bellied Leafbird, White-headed Bulbul, Eurasian Jay, Grey Treepie, Chestnut-bellied Nuthatch, White-tailed Robin, Scaly Thrush and Chestnut-flanked White-eye. The waterfall may even produce a Yellow Wagtail and more

6.) Bird Hide inside park ; White-tailed Robin, Rufous-bellied, Small Niltava, Paradise-Flycatcher, Hill Blue, Blue-throated, Snowy-browed Flycatcher, Lesser Shortwing, Velvet-fronted Nuthatch, Warblers, Silver-eared Laughingthrush, Silver-eared Mesia, Slaty-backed Forktail, Pygmy Wren-Babbler, and more.

1. PAYMENTS POLICY

The payments can be made via **Banking, WISE, PayPal**. You can pay in the full amount 100% or confirm your booking we need at least 40% deposit. Immediate payment, your booking will record and confirm. The client is responsible for any bank transfer fee(s). Please remark PayPal payment, It is charge 4.5%

For the remaining 60%

By bank transfer: Pay 30 days before the tour start. Please attach the payment confirmation when making payment.

By cash: Pay to our Birding Guide on the first day tour. It is possible to pay with your country currency or in THB.

Note: Pay by cash, please let us know ASAP but at least 30 days before the tour starts. If the service is already carried half-way through the itinerary, but you still do not pay the outstanding amount. We will drop the service immediately until you pay.

2. CANCELLATION THE TOUR POLICY

The business partner and client shall notify us in writing of any cancellation prior to the minimum notice dates, otherwise a late cancellation charge will be applied as follows :

In case of cancellation before 90 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 0% of the total amount in any case, Company refund money back to you 100%.

In case of cancellation within 90 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 15% of the total amount in any case.

In case of cancellation within 60 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 50% of the total amount in any case.

In case of cancellation within 30 days before the tour start. It is no refund in any case.

In case of No show during the tour. It is no refund in any case.



3. POSTPONE THE TOUR POLICY

In case of postpone 60 days before program tour start, We will not deduct any business opportunity loss fees. We'll refund you the amount incurred after deducting the transfer fee or keep it with us. We will issue a credit note for the next use with a period of 6 months from the date of request to postpone the tour. After that, if you are still unable to determine the next travel date, We will transfer the money back to you for the amount incurred less the transfer fee.

In case of postpone during 30 days before program tour start, In the event that you request to postpone the travel date of the tour for reasons in all cases. We will charge from you 50% of the total tour cost incurred as a result of the loss of business opportunity. The remaining amount will be refunded to you based on the amount accrued less after the transfer fee. And there is no policy to collect money as credit notes.

In case postpone less than 30 days before program tour start, It is no refund in any case.
