

# Thailand 3 Days Kaeng Krachan MISSION POSSIBLE



❖ Phetchaburi ❖ is one of the central provinces of Thailand. Neighboring provinces are (from north clockwise) Ratchaburi, Samut Songkhram and Prachuap Khiri Khan. In the west it borders Tanintharyi Division of Myanmar. Geography Phetchaburi is located at the northern end of the Malay Peninsula, with the Gulf of Thailand to the East and the Tanaosi mountain range forming the boundary to Myanmar. Except these border mountains most of the province is a flat plain area. With an area of about 3000 km² the Kaeng Krachan National Park is Thailand largest national park, covering nearly half of

the province. It protects mostly rainforests in the mountains along the boundary to Myanmar, but also the Kaeng Krachan reservoir is part of the park.

\*Kaeng Krachan \* is the largest national park of Thailand, located at the northern end of the Malay Peninsula. Due to its location near the touristical town Hua Hin it is a popular park.

Geography The park covers parts of the districts Nong Ya Plong, Kaeng Krachan and Tha Yang of Phetchaburi Province, and of Hua Hin of Prachuap Khiri Khan Province. It consists mainly of rain forests within the eastern slope of the Tenasserim Mountain Range. The highest elevation is at 1,200 m., the mean elevation of the area is at Two main rivers originate within the park, the Pranburi River and the Phetchaburi River. The Phetchaburi is



blocked by the Kaeng Krachan dam at the eastern border of the park. The dam creates a lake covering an area of 46.5 km<sup>2</sup>. The dam was built in 1966.

History The park has been included in the list of ASEAN heritage parks. In 2005 it was also submitted to UNESCO for consideration as a future world heritage site. Thailand's largest



national park , Kaeng Krachan is a superb park for trekkers and a paradise for birdwatchers. dominated by semi-evergreen forests, with hill evergreen forest above 1,200 m. the lower reaches of two major streams have been dammed and are mostly deforested, but the upper reaches may still contain some moist, valley bottom forest



at low elevation. **Fauna and Flora** The forests contain a very diverse collection of tree species, both continental trees like oaks, chestnuts, and maples, but also trees found on the Malay Peninsula like palms. 57 species of mammals Bird community The park is home of more than 400 birds species including 6 hornbill species. Kaeng Krachan far from Bangkok 3 hours.

\* Bird Hide \* Thai call Bo Nok "Bo" in mean water hole, "Nok" is mean Bird, Made by man. the magic place for bird watching, for here is wonderful place to see many specie bird come to take a baht drinking and feeding, Create by local people in the village, people live around the forest park they had to be hunter before make a farm. He know well about the





trail of mammal and bird living around his area, he will make small pond like a trap and build 2-3 hind for people hide in side with camera, In every day farmer fill a fresh



water 15 liter (pond size wide 3 foot - long 4 foot - water deep 4 inch) and leave some fruits for bird and mammal eat. Bird start to active on 07:00 - 17:00 if a day the weather around 30 C. or sunshine no cloudy, bird much more active at small pool for take a bath. since 2008 the first pond build by Lung Sin and another water holes around here also have manage by Nung, Nui, Thun there's water hole show a lot of birds live around more 30-40 specie per day such as Bar-backed Partridge, Scaly-breasted Partridge, Kalij Pheasant, Red Junglefowl, Crested Goshawk, Red-legged Crake, Grey-headed Woodpecker, Eared Pitta, Emerald Dove, White-browned Scimitar-Babbler, Large Scimitar-babbler, Black-crested Bulbul, Black-headed Bulbul, Stripe-throated Bulbul, Racket-tailed Treepie, Green Magpie, Greater Necklaced Laughingthrush, Brown-cheeked Fulvetta, Siberian Blue Robin, White-rumped Shama, Tickell's Blue Flycatcher, etc. And also small mammal such as Greater Mouth Deer, Squirrels, Wild Pig. The water hole located out side Kaeng Krachan by the forest edge, if you want to go for birding or bird photography, Please contact Wild Bird before booking tour because we don't put in the program and we will need to check information before take you there.



## **Tour Itinerary**

Tour Start & End : Bangkok

**Destination**: Kaeng Krachan

Hope to see : June - Sep. 60 sp., Oct. - Jan. 75 sp., Feb.- Apr.110 sp.

Level : Easy Walk

#### Day 1 : Bangkok > Kaeng Krachan

Then we will transfer 3 hr. to KKC., Bird watching full day in side park, we have many places for you on follow this **1.) Kaeng Krachan Dam :** We might visit this area in the afternoon of the 2nd day before we get to Samarn Bird Camp or the 3rd day afternoon. Anyway, birds that can be seen here such as Grey-breasted Prinia, Paddyfield Pipit, Forest Wagtail, Coppersmith and Green-eared Barbets, Asian Hoopoe, Black-collared Starling, Common Iora, Greater Racket-tailed Drongo, Racket-tailed Treepie, Asian Barred Owlet, Plaintive Cuckoo, Black-crested Bulbul, Red-wattled Lapwing etc.

- 2.) Km. 7-13 (Dry Evergreen Forest): It's quite a flat terrain, very easy to walk. Only simply birding along the road we can connect with Black-naped Oriole, Blue-winged and Golden-fronted Leafbirds, Great Iora, Oriental Pied and Great Hornbills, Blue-bearded Bee-eater, Dollarbird, Greater Yellownape, Common and Greater Flameback, Great Slaty Woodpecker, Red-wattled Lapwing, Red Junglefowl, Kalij Pheasant, Black-and-Red, Black-and-Yellow and Banded Broadbills (all Broadbills can be seen during March-June), Asian Barred Owlet, Olive-backed and Crimson Sunbirds, Greeneared Barbet, Crested Serpent Eagle, Black Eagle, Black Baza (winter), Black-thighed Falconet, various species of Accipiters, Asian Fairy Bluebird, Ashy Wood Swallow, Grey-rumped Treeswift, Black-crested and Stripe-throated Bulbuls, etc.
- 3.) Km. 15 Ban Krang Campground & Km.18 : This road requires us to use a pickup truck or 4-wheel drive vehicle to pass through a stream three times.

This area is a transition from dry evergreen forest to moist evergreen forest and also clear streams lying parallel to the jungle dirt road, which some part that we are going for birding will be a closed canopy and dense vegetation area. However, species that can be found here are superb such as Blue Pitta, Hooded Pitta (May-July), Blue-winged Pitta (May-July), Great and Oriental Pied Hornbills, Scaly-breasted Partridge, Orang-breasted Trogon, Green Magpie, Asian Barred Owlet, Blue-bearded Bee-eater, Ochraceous, Black-crested and Stripe-throated Bulbuls, Great Iora, Sultan Tit, Velvet-fronted Nuthatch, Greater Racket-tailed, Bronzed, Ashy and Hair-crested Drongos, Hill Blue Flycatcher, Scarlet and Ashy Minivets, Verditer Flycatcher, Pin Striped Tit-Babbler, Blue-winged and Golden-fronted Leafbirds, Banded Kingfisher, Oriental Dwarf Kingfisher (May-June), White-crested, Greater Necklaced and Lesser Necklaced Laughingthrush, Himalayan Cuckoo, Drongo Cuckoo,



Chestnut-winged Cuckoo, Violet and Asian Emerald Cuckoos, Emerald Dove, Vernal Hanging Parrot and a lot more good species.

**Top mammals:** Lesser Mouse Deer, Black-giant Squirrel, Barking Deer, Spectacled Langur, Stumptailed Macaque, White-handed Gibbon and Yellow-throated Marten, Wild Elephant, Leopard, Malayan Sun Bear and Guar. **Twilight time** Large-tailed Nightjar, Indian Nightjar, Brown Hawk-Owl, Collared Scopes-Owl, Asian Barred Owlet.

Stay: Baan Maka or Smarn Bird Camp

#### Day 2: Birding on Summit

Early wake up for today, guide will bring you to birding & bird photography all day on summit of national park at **Km. 26 - 36. Phaneon Thung : This road requires us to use a 4-wheel drive vehicle to pass through a stream three times**. Here is good place for different birds species and mammals. You will enjoy an exciting search for Grey Peacock-Pheasant, Bar-backed Partridge, Kalij Pheasant, however, and possibly also Long-billed Partridge. Mountain Hawk-Eagle, Besra, Wreath Hornbill, Crested Jay, Silver-breasted Broadbill, Dusky Broadbill, Banded Broadbill, Chestnutbreasted Malkoha, White-hooded Babbler, Great Slaty Woodpecker, Grey Treepie. And 4 Species Of the hornbills Great Hornbill, Wrinkled Hornbill, Wreathed Hornbill and Plain-pouched Hornbill to present. 16:00 pm. Transfer back to resort.

Stay: Baan Maka or Smarn Bird Camp

Note: The summit site close in rainy season on during August - October

#### Day 3: Bird Hide outside national park > Bangkok

After breakfast we will make a short ride (15 mins.) to a bird hide outside the park. We will spend a half day settle into a bird hide and wait for birds coming to the artificial pool such as Eared Pitta (hard & seldom seen), Red Junglefowl, Kalij Pheasant, Scaly-breasted Partridge, Streak-eared, Stripe-throated and Black-crested Bulbuls, Pin-striped Tit-Babbler, Puff-throated Babbler, Racket-tailed Treepie, Tickel's Blue Flycatcher, White-browed and Large Scimitar-Babblers, White-crested, Lesser Necklaced and Greater Nacklaced Laughingthrushes, Green Magpie, Abbott's Babbler, Brown-cheeked Fulvetta, Black-naped Monarch, Siberian Blue Robin, a very shy Red-legged and Slaty-legged Crakes (hard, passage migrants), Pied Fantail, White-rumped Shama, Greater Coucal etc. Typical mammals at the pool: Lesser Mouse Deer, many species of Squirrels.

In case of rain or bird watching during the rainy season, the number of bird species at this site will be reduced. Our guides will take you to see or photograph birds in other areas outside or go back to see the birds in the park once.

17:00 pm. We will transfer 3 hours back to Bangkok.

The business partner and client shall notify us in writing of any cancellation prior to the minimum notice dates, otherwise a late cancellation charge will be applied as follows:

In case of cancellation before 120 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 0% of the total amount in any case, Company refund money back to you 100%.

In case of cancellation within 90 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 35% of the total amount in any case.

In case of cancellation within 60 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 50% of the total amount in any case.

In case of cancellation within 30 days before the tour start. It is no refund in any case.

In case of No show during the tour. It is no refund in any case.

#### 3. POSTPONE THE TOUR POLICY

In case of postpone 60 days before program tour start, We will not deduct any business opportunity loss fees. We'll refund you the amount incurred after deducting the transfer fee or keep it with us. We will issue a credit note for the next use with a period of 6 months from the date of request to postpone the tour.
