Day 1 : Phuket > Had Thai Mueng > Pakarang > Sri Phang Nga

07:30 Guide & Driver pick you up at the hotel in Phuket

Then transfer 40 min. to **Had Thai Mueng** for watching Spotted Wood Owl, Glossy Starling then transfer 40 min. to **Had Pakarang cape**, hope to see Gray-tailed Tattler, Ruddy Turnstone, Terek Sandpiper, Whimbrel, Pacific Reed Heron, Plovers, Egrets, Terns and Gulls.

Then transfer 1 hour to birding at Sri Phang Nga np. 18:30 check at the resort in Kuraburi.

Day 2 : Sri Phang Nga

Full day birding in SPN np. Habitat is rain forest a home of 250 species of birds, we will hope to see Blyth's Frogmouth*, Gould's Frogmouth*, Banded Pitta, Banded, Blue-banded Kingfisher, Chestnut-napped Forktail, Buff-Vented, Yellow-bellied, Streak, Red-eyed, Hairy-backed Bulbul, Whiskered Treeswift, Purple-naped Sunbird, Red-throated Barbet, Grey-capped Woodpecker, Lesser Cuckoo-shrike, Bar-bellied Cuckoo-shrike, Crested Jay, Rufous-collared Kingfisher, Lesser Fish-Eagle, Rafale's Malkoha, Blue-and-White Flycatcher, Large Blue Flycatcher, Blyth's Paradise-Flycatcher, Chestnut-winged, Grey-throated Babbler, Bushy-crested, Wreath Hornbill and more.

Evening guide bring you to see Brown Wood Owl at roosting spot outside national park.

Day 3 : Sri Phang Nga > Klong Sang Ney > Kotiean > Khao Sok

Morning we start birding at **Tung Chali sub unit forest** hope to see : White-crowned, Great, Wreath Hornbill, Slender-billed Oriole, Brown-backed Needletail, Red-eyed Bulbul, Rufous, Banded Woodpeckers, Lesser Green Leafbird, Green Iora, Gold-whiskered Barbet, Red-throated Barbet, Purple-naped Spiderhunter, Van Hansel's Sunbird and more.

Then transfer 10 min. to **Nang Yon Canal Weir Irrigation Project**, There is a small reservoir where many rare birds are often found, such as Glossy Swiftlet, Silver-rumped Spinetail, Germain's Swiftlet, Gray-rumped Treeswift, Chestnut-headed Bee-eater, Great Argus (sound), Hawk Eagle, Banded Kingfisher and more. If we walk a little further from the weir, about 1 kilometer, you will find a forest edge area that is a mix of open fields and durian orchards belonging to local villagers. You may see a large hawk soaring above and hear the sound of a Great Argus echoing from afar.

For lunch, our guide will take you to eat at a Thai restaurant "Bai Toey" in Takua Pa District. It is a famous Thai restaurant has been Awarded a Michelin Star four years in a row, we hope you'll love the food here. After lunch, around 3:00 p.m., the sun began to not be so hot. Your guide will take you bird watching at **Khlong Sang Nae** or Little Amazon. Takua Pa is only 2 miles away.

This is a short canal. that originates from Khao Bang Tao before ending at the Takua Pa River. There is a small forest area. that is full of biological diversity Strange plants that grow Along the banks of Khlong Sang Neh Most tourists come to take a canoe to admire the beauty of nature at Khlong Sang Nae. It is to see the ancient banyan tree, hundreds of years old, spreading its branches along the canal. In some parts it hangs in front of us like a curtain of a banyan tree tunnel for you to take a boat ride through. Another highlight of the cruise. It is to see snakes, including Green Snakes, Mangrove snake (*Boiga dendrophila*), and pythons, which you don't have to be afraid of being dangerous because we are watching the snakes from a distance. And during the day the snake will sleep still. It curls up against a tree and waits to come out to feed at night. But for bird watching The guide will take you on a bird-watching tour on the 200-meter cement walkway. Some of the common local birds include: Ruddy Kingfisher, Mangrove Pitta, Black-and-Red Broadbill, Chestnut-breasted Malkoha, Orange-bellied Flowerpecker, Van Hansell's Sunbird, Olive-winged Bulbul, etc.

Then drive 10 min. to **Kotiean open area** many specie show up here such as Raptors & Eagle, Red-throated Pipit, River & Grey-headed Lapwing, White-shouldered, Black-collared Starling, Little Green, Blue-tailed Bee-eater, Watercock, Purple Swamphen, Oriental Pratincole, Pacific Golden, Grey Plover, Wood & Common Sandpiper, Plaintive Cuckoo, Common Flameback, White-rumped Munia some time see Oriental Plover(rare). **Night watch:** guide bring you to searching *Brown Wood Owl, Collard Scope Owl, Oriental Bay Owl* at the community forest not far from resort.

Day 4 : Khao Sok > Phang Nga

Our accommodation will be near the entrance to the national park. In the morning, our guide will take you to see birds in the park's parking lot. Our first target of the morning is the Rufous-collared Kingfisher, this's one bir is very difficult to find in southern Thailand and for at this spot we found every time. After seeing this bird, we will walk back to the accommodation for breakfast before going back to see birds again on the nature trails in the park. We expect to see other bird species as well, including: White-crowned Hornbill, Red-breaded Bee-eater, Banded Kingfisher, Chestnut-napped Forktail, Rufous Piculet, Grey-capped, Bamboo, Banded Woodpecker, Buff-Vented, Yellow-bellied, Cream-vented, Red-eyed, Spectacled Bulbul, Red-throated Barbet, Lesser Cuckoo-shrike, Bar-bellied Cuckoo-shrike, Little, Purple-naped, Plain Sunbird, Spectacled, Yellow-eared Spiderhunter Brown-throated, Orange-bellied, Yellow-vented, Thick-billed Flowerpecker, Pin-tailed Parrotfinch, Black-and-Red, Silver-breasted, Banded Broadbill, and more.

Then transfer 1:30 hours to hotel in Phang Nga province.

Day 5 : Ao Phang Nga > Sam Chong Mangrove > Phuket

After we had breakfast at the hotel, we short drive only 1.5 km. to birding at **Ao Phang Nga Mangrove forest** the location only crossing road from hotel. our target birds for here is Mangrove Pitta, Mangrove Whistler, Crow-billed Drongo, Ruddy, Collared, Brown-winged, Black-caped Kingfisher, Ashy Tailorbird, Streak-breasted Woodpecker, Pacific Swallow, Buffy fish-Owl and more.

Then drive 30 min. to **Sam Chong(Phang Nga) mangrove forest research station**, We would revisit the mangroves to look for other birds or to search for the same ones we hadn't seen at the first spot that morning, and this was the last place we would see them.

For lunch, you can choose from two restaurants, the first place is [Sam Chong Seafood restaurant](#) located near the birdwatching spot or second place at [Bay View Cafe](#) (Samet Nangshe view point) Located in Ban Samet Nangshe. Khlong Khian Subdistrict It is a viewpoint on the top of an 800 meter high mountain. It is one of the most beautiful viewpoints in Phang Nga Province. Marvel at the unseen mountain views of Phang Nga Bay. Especially during sunrise that appears among the limestone mountains of Phang Nga Bay Or will it be during the day? with the mountain atmosphere paired with mangrove forests, From the restaurant's terrace, you can see the beauty of nature within Phang Nga Bay as far as the eye can see. The calm, emerald green waters are lined with many large and small limestone mountains and lined with bright green mangrove forests. As the sun slowly shines, golden light rises up behind the valley. Then transfer 30 min. back to Phuket.

CONDITIONS OF AGREEMENT AND TOUR SERVICE POLICY

1. PAYMENTS POLICY

The payments can be made via **Banking, WISE, PayPal**. You can pay in the full amount 100% or confirm your booking we need at least 25% deposit. **Immediate payment, your booking will record and confirm.** The client is responsible for any money transfer fee(s).

For the remaining 75% : Pay 30 days before the tour start. Please attach the payment confirmation when making payment.

2. CANCELLATION THE TOUR POLICY

The business partner and client shall notify us in writing of any cancellation prior to the minimum notice dates, otherwise a late cancellation charge will be applied as follows :

In case of cancellation before 120 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 0% of the total amount in any case, Company refund money back to you 100%.



In case of cancellation within 90 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 35% of the total amount in any case.

In case of cancellation within 60 days before the tour start. The cancellation fee is 50% of the total amount in any case.

In case of cancellation within 30 days before the tour start. It is no refund in any case.

In case of No show during the tour. It is no refund in any case.

3. POSTPONE THE TOUR POLICY

In case of postpone 60 days before program tour start, We will not deduct any business opportunity loss fees. We'll refund you the amount incurred after deducting the transfer fee or keep it with us. We will issue a credit note for the next use with a period of 6 months from the date of request to postpone the tour. After that, if you are still unable to determine the next travel date, We will transfer the money back to you for the amount incurred less the transfer fee.

In case of postpone during 30 days before program tour start, In the event that you request to postpone the travel date of the tour for reasons in all cases. We will charge from you 50% of the total tour cost incurred as a result of the loss of business opportunity. The remaining amount will be refunded to you based on the amount accrued less after the transfer fee. And there is no policy to collect money as credit notes.

In case postpone less than 30 days before program tour start, It is no refund in any case.
